For Immediate Press Release

The Central Union High School District will begin offering In-Person Learning for all grade levels beginning the week of April 12 with a focus on 9<sup>th</sup> grade students. The morning Distance Learning schedule will remain in place. Attendance in the afternoon is optional for students. In-Person Learning sessions will be held from 1:45-3:45 Tuesday through Friday. Transportation will be provided as well. In-Person Learning groups will be limited to no more than 15 students.

All students and staff are to do their own symptom check before coming to campus, enter through the designated entrances where they are screened again. Students will check in to the session by scanning a QR code then report to their classroom. All students and staff are to wear a face covering and maintain social distancing.
